BILL

To appropriate an additional amount of money for the requirements of the State; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:—

Appropriation of additional amount of money for requirements of State

- 1. (1) Appropriations by Parliament of additional money from the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State in the 2021/22 financial year to votes and the main divisions within a vote, and for the purposes that are specified, are set out in the Schedule.
- (2) The appropriations envisaged in subsection (1) are subject to the Appropriation Act, 2021 (Act No. 10 of 2021).

Short title 10

2. This Act is called the Second Special Appropriation Act, 2021.
