MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES ACT, 1965

APPLICATION FEE: APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO COMPOUND OR DISPENSE MEDICINES

The Director-General has, in terms of Regulation 18 (2) of the General Regulations (Government Notice No. 24727 of 10 April 2003) relating to the Licence to Dispense or Compound and Dispense Medicines made under the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act No. 101 of 1965) ("the Act") determined in the Schedule the fees payable on application for a licence to compound or dispense medicines referred to in section 22C of the Act, and it is hereby published for general information.

SCHEDULE

The following application fees which include Value Added Tax (VAT) shall be payable to the Director-General:

- (a) A fee to accompany the application form: R1000-00.
- (b) A fee to accompany subsequent applications in respect of additional premises where compounding and dispensing of medicines will be carried out or relocation application: R250-00
- (c) A fee to accompany the renewal application form, even in respect of more than one premises: R500-00
- (d) A licence fee for the three year period payable either in full in advance or annually within 90 days from the date of issuing the licence: R600-00 or R200 annually.
