

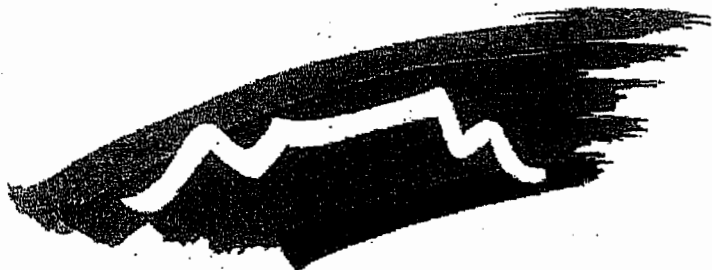
NOTICE 123 OF 2009

DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY

MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT 17 OF 1941

PROPOSED PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF THE
REPRESENTATION OF TABLE MOUNTAIN

I, Mandisi Mpahlwa, Minister of Trade and Industry, in pursuance of the requirements of section 13 of the Merchandise Marks Act 17 of 1941 hereby give notice that the City of Cape Town (a metropolitan municipality) has conveyed a request for the prohibition in terms of section 15(1) of the said Act on the use of Table Mountain, in combination with the phrases "CITY OF CAPE TOWN", "ISIXEKO SASEKAPA" and "STAD KAAPSTAD" as depicted below, in connection with any trade, business, profession or occupation or in connection with any trademark, mark, or trade description applied to goods, other than the use thereof by the abovementioned municipality or its mandatories.
