SCHEDULE

DEFINING OF PRODUCTION AREA: HOUT BAY

That portion of land situate within the following boundaries:

Start at the point where the 200 metre contour line intersects the Constantia Neck road (M63), in the vicinity of Constantia Neck; thence northeast with said Constantia Neck road to a point where it joins Rhodes Avenue; thence northeast with said avenue to a point where it intersects the southern boundary of the Cape Peninsula National Park; thence generally west with the southern boundary of said park where it joins Victoria road (M6); thence south with said road for approximately 2,5 km to a point where said Victoria road turns east and joins the Constantia Neck road; thence south with said Constantia Neck road to a point where it intersects the northwestern border of Tokai State bush; thence northeast with said northwestern state bush border to a point where the 200 metre contour intersects said border; thence generally northeast with said contour line to a point where it intersects the Constantia Neck road, in the vicinity of Constantia Neck, the point of beginning mentioned above.
