SCHEDULE**Definitions**

1. In these regulations—

“the Act” means the National Environment Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act. No. 10 of 2004); and

“the Regulations” means the Threatened or Protected Species Regulations, 2007 published in Government Gazette No. 29657, Government Notice No. R 152 of 23 February 2007, as amended by Government Notice No. R. 69 of 28 January 2008, published in Government Gazette No. 30703.

Amendment of regulation 1 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 1 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution of the definition “management plan” for the following definition:

“management plan” as applicable, means—
