With reference to Government Notice No. 477 of 2005, which was published in Government Gazette No. 27428 of 31 March 2005, it is hereby announced that fees, which are payable in terms of section 8 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992), for services rendered have been amended. The fees which are payable with effect **from 12** April 2006 are the following:

Issuing of an abridged computerprinted or handwritten birth or (a) death certificate: Provided that no fees are payable for the issuing of the prescribed certificate on registration of a birth or R10,00 death Issuing of an unabridged birth or death certificate, or a (b) reproduction of the relevant register or a reproduction of any supporting documentation coupled to the register concerned, as well as verification of information from birth and death registers in regard to an individual: Provided that where the reproduction or verification is required for official purposes within the meaning of paragraph (h) below, it shall be free of R50,00 Application for **any** amendment to the birth register of any **person** (c) including the noting of the fact of adoption in the birth register of a person in terms of the Child Care Act, 1983, but excluding the re-registration of a birth in terms of section 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992), which is free **₫** charge R55,00 Application for any change of the forenames or surname of a minor (d) (section 24 and 25 of Act No. 51 of 1992) R55.00 Application for the changing of a major's forenames in the birth (e) register (section 24 of Act No. 51 of 1992). The insertion of a major's forenames and surname in the birth register (section 23 of Act No. 51 of 1992), however, is free of charge if his or her identity document was issued with the forename repeated as a
