## INDEPENDENT COMMISSION FOR THE REMUNERATION OF PUBLIC OFFICE BEARERS

## RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND BENEFITS OF THE CHAIRPERSON AND DEPUTY CHAIRPERSON OF A PROVINCIAL HOUSE OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS

- 1. The Independent Commission for the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers was established in terms of section 219 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act, 1996, and members of the Commission were duly appointed in terms of the Independent Commission for the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1997, to make recommendations regarding the salaries, allowances and benefits of office bearers.
- 2. In terms of section 8(4) of the Independent Commission for the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1997, the Commission shall publish annually in the Gazette, recommendations regarding the salaries, allowances and benefits of office bearers, as defined.
- 3. The Commission duly published recommendations on 08 July 2005, but is necessitated to supplement its recommendations due to changes in legislation affecting certain office bearer positions.
- 4. The Eastern Cape Provincial Legislature lawfully passed the House of Traditional Leaders Amendment Act, 2005 (Act No. 3 of 2005 (EC)), which, amongst others, changed the status of the positions of Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson of the Eastern Cape Provincial House of Traditional Leaders from part time to full time public office bearers.
- 5. As a consequence it became necessary to grade those positions in terms of the existing remuneration structure for the allocation of full time remuneration of the incumbents.

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
