AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES EXPORT ACT

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE EXPORT OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES¹

Commencement [29th October 2002]

PART 1- PRELIMINARY

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Agricultural Commodities Export Act.

2 Interpretation

In this Act unless the context otherwise requires —

“**agricultural commodity**” means all species of fruit, vegetables, root crops, spices and other plant materials;

“**Chief Executive Officer**” means the Government chief executive officer responsible for agriculture;²

“**Inspector**” means the Chief Executive Officer, any person designated as an Inspector under this Act or any person designated as an Inspector under the Plant Quarantine Act³;

“**Minister**” means the Minister responsible for agriculture;⁴

“**plant material**” means all materials of plant origin.
