# AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF THE BAILIFFS' OFFICE<sup>1</sup>

Commencement [4th August 2000]

#### PART I - PRELIMINARY

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Bailiffs Act.

#### 2 Interpretation

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

- "Bailiff" means the Chief Bailiff and any other Bailiff appointed pursuant to section 4;
- "Bailiffs' district" means a district specified under section 6;
- "Court" means the Supreme Court of Tonga or any Court;
- "Judgment Debtor" means a person liable under a judgment or distress warrant issued by a Court;
- "Registrar" means Registrar of the Supreme Court;
- "Minister" means the Minister of Justice:
- "Ministry" means the Ministry of Justice;
