CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS AND LUGGAGE BY SEA ACT

AN ACT TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE ATHENS CONVENTION CONCERNING INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS AND THEIR LUGGAGE BY SEA¹

BE IT ENACTED by the King and Legislative Assembly of Tonga in the Legislature of the Kingdom as follows:

Commencement [30th November 1988]

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Carriage of Passengers and Luggage by Sea Act.

2 Application to the Crown

This Act shall bind the Crown.

3 Convention to have the force of law

- (1) Subject to this section the provisions of the Convention known as “the Athens Convention relating to the Carriage of Passengers and their Luggage by Sea” as set out in the Schedule to this Act so far as they relate to the rights and liabilities of carriers, carriers' servants and agents, passengers and other persons, and subject to the provisions of this Act, have the force of law in the Kingdom of Tonga.
