EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT

AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT IN THE KINGDOM¹

Commencement [13th September, 2007]

PART I - PRELIMINARY

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Emergency Management Act.

2 Interpretation

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

"authorised officer" means a person authorised to exercise emergency powers for a state of emergency under this Act;

"Chief Executive Officer" means the Government chief executive officer responsible for emergency management;²

"emergency" means an event, actual or imminent, which endangers or threatens to endanger life, property or the environment and which requires a significant and co-ordinated response;

"emergency management" means arrangements about managing the potential adverse effects of an event, including mitigating community risk, preparing for and responding to threatening events and recovering from an emergency;
