ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS 1

Made under section 24 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Act 2003

Commencement [1st November 2010]

1 Short Title

These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations.

2 Interpretation

- (1) In these Regulations -
 - "Act" means the Environmental Impact Assessment Act 2003; and
 - "Secretariat" means the Secretariat of the Environmental Assessment Committee.
- (2) The terms and phrases defined in the Act shall be given the same meaning in these Regulations, unless the context requires otherwise.

3 Forms and Fees

- (1) The forms set out in Schedule 1, are hereby prescribed for the purposes of the Act and these Regulations.
- (2) The fees set out in Schedule 2, are hereby prescribed for the purposes of the Act and these Regulations.
- (3) Where the Act or these Regulations require a development application to be referred to a Determining Authority, the Minister, considering the advice of the Secretariat, may require additional copies of the development application,
