



VILLAGE REGULATIONS¹

Made under section 26 of the Government Act

1. LEIMATU‘A, FELETOA AND MATAIKA

Repealed by Districts (Animal Enclosure) Regulations, GS 8/2009

2. TU‘ANUKU, LONGOMAPU, TEFISI, TAOA AND VAIMALO

Made by the District Officer 22nd December, 1958²

1. Every person who is the holder of a tax allotment, or a permit to occupy and work any tax allotment, shall in the months shown plant the following crops in his allotment—

*20 manioke or taro plants	January to December
*40 kape plants	March to August
*40 ‘ufilei or ‘Ufi plants	June to July
15 banana plants	October to December
10 pata or mamae plants	October to November
25 pineapple plants	March
10 hopa plants	March
2 breadfruit trees in town allotments.	

*Any of these may be substituted by kumala or taro.

2. Any person failing to comply with this Regulation will be subject to the penalties provided by section 26 of the Government Act.

3. HA ‘ALAUFULI, TU‘ANEKIVALE, HOLEVA, KOLOA, MANGIA, HOUMA, HA ‘AKIO, TA ‘ANEA

Made by the District Officer 22nd December, 1958³

1. Every person who is the holder of a tax allotment or a permit to occupy and work any tax allotment, shall in the months shown plant the following crops in his allotment —

25 manioke plants	January to December
40 kape plants	March to August
20 banana plants	October to November
20 hopa plants	October to November
50 'ufi plants	June to August
25 pineapple plants	March
50 talo plants	August to September

2 breadfruit trees in town allotments.
2. Any person failing to comply with this Regulation will be subject to the penalties provided by section 26 of the Government Act.

4. *'OTEA, FALEVAI, TAUNGA, OVAKA, MATAMAKA, LAPE, NUAPAPU, KAPA, HUNGA, FUA 'AMOTU, 'EUAKAFA, 'EUEIKI, MU 'OMU 'A, TOTOKA 'UTA AND VAKA 'EITU*

Made by the District Officer 22nd December, 1958⁴

1. Every person who is the holder of a tax allotment, or a permit to occupy and work any tax allotment, shall in the months shown plant the following crops in his allotment —

*40 kape plants	March to August
*40 'ufilei or 'ufi plants	June to July
10 banana plants	October to December
10 pata or mamae plants	October to November
25 pineapple plants	March
10 hopa plants	March
