FORESTRY

The Chief Forester (Qualifications) (Scotland) Regulations 2019

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 73(2) of the Forestry and Land Management (Scotland) Act 2018⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Chief Forester (Qualifications) (Scotland) Regulations 2019 and come into force on 1 April 2019.

Qualifications required to be chief forester

2.—(1) A person is qualified to be the chief forester if that person—

- (a) is a Chartered Forester or Chartered Arboriculturist, or
- (b) possesses one of the following qualifications in a forestry or arboriculture subject—
 - (i) a bachelor of science degree (with honours),
 - (ii) an integrated master's degree,
 - (iii) a master of science degree,
 - (iv) a doctoral degree.

(2) In paragraph (1)—

“Chartered Arboriculturist” means a member of the Institute of Chartered Foresters qualified as a chartered arboriculturist,

“Chartered Forester” means a member of the Institute of Chartered Foresters qualified as a chartered forester,
