The A483 Trunk Road (Newbridge Bypass, Newbridge, Wrexham) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

Made 1 November 2011
Coming into force 14 November 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2) make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 14 November 2011 and its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Newbridge Bypass, Newbridge, Wrexham) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and by the emergency services;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means that length of the trunk road, known as Newbridge Bypass, in the County Borough of Wrexham which extends from a point at its junction with the A539, (Junction 1), to a point at its junction with the A5 at Halton Roundabout;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 19.00 hours on 14 November 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.
