The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 108(2A), (3C), (5) and (6) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990<sup>(1)</sup>, makes the following Regulations.

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Compensation) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2017 and come into force on 6th April 2017.

**Amendments to prescribed descriptions of development**

**2.** In regulation 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Compensation) (England) Regulations 2015<sup>(2)</sup>, in paragraph (d) after “C,” insert “CA,”.
