**The A483 Trunk Road (Ffairfach to
Llandeilo, Carmarthenshire)
(Temporary Traffic Restriction and
Prohibitions) Order 2011**

Made 7 October 2011

Coming into force 17 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and restricted by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 17 October 2011. The title to this Order is The A483 Trunk Road (Ffairfach to Llandeilo, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restriction and Prohibitions) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road from Ffairfach to Llandeilo, in the County of Carmarthenshire, specified in the Schedules to this Order.

“works period,” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 17 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order.
