**The A477 Trunk Road (East of Red  
Roses, Carmarthenshire)  
(Temporary 40 MPH Speed Limit)  
Order 2011.**

*Made* *5 October 2011*

*Coming into force* *17 October 2011*

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the St Clears to Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477) (hereinafter referred to as the “trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted for safety reasons.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other enabling powers<sup>(2)</sup>, make this Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 17 October 2011. Its title is The A477 Trunk Road (East of Red Roses, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary 40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2. (1) In this Order “works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 00.01 hours on 17 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in that length of the trunk road in Carmarthenshire that extends from a point 238 metres north east of the centre line of its junction with the B4314 Class II Road to Tavernspite to a point 4390
