Order 2011**

Coming into force

10 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A48) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted or prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 10 October 2011 and its title is The A48 Trunk Road (Pont Abraham Roundabout to Cross Hands Business Park, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibitions) Order 2011.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the lengths of the trunk road” (*“y darnau o’r gefnffordd”*) means the lengths of the A48 trunk road between Pont Abraham and Cross Hands in the County of Carmarthenshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 10 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

6. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to turn right onto or off the trunk road at the locations specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

7. Subject to the provisions of article 8, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order whilst the provision of article 5 is in force.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only at such times and to such extent as traffic signs indicate the restrictions or prohibitions referred to therein.

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
