The A494 Trunk Road (East of
Ruthin, Denbighshire) (Temporary
Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction)
Order 2011

Made 23 September 2011

Coming into force 3 October 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the A494 Dolgellau to South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”) are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon;

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers (2), make this Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 3 October 2011. The title to this Order is The A494 Trunk Road (East of Ruthin, Denbighshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction) Order 2011.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 06.00 hours on 3 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.
