The A470 Trunk Road (Taffs Well Interchange, Cardiff to Nantgarw Interchange, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 3 October 2011 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Taffs Well Interchange, Cardiff to Nantgarw Interchange, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

2.—1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order or by the emergency services;

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means those lengths of the A470 trunk road between Taffs Well Interchange in the City and County of Cardiff and Nantgarw Interchange in the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf specified in the Schedule to this Order:

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 3 October 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been permanently removed.
