**The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge
on Wye to Llangurig, Powys)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions and
Prohibition) Order 2011**

Made 8 September 2011

Coming into force 19 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾ and of all other enabling powers⁽²⁾, make this Order.

1. This Order comes into force on 19 September 2011. The title to this Order is The A470 Trunk Road (Newbridge on Wye to Llangurig, Powys) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions and Prohibition) Order 2011.

2. —1) In this Order:

“the lengths of the trunk road” (“*y darnau o’r gefnffordd*”) means the lengths of the trunk road between Newbridge on Wye and Llangurig in the County of Powys specified in the Schedule to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 08:00 hours on 19 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.
