**The A483 Trunk Road (Cilyrychen  
Level Crossing, Llandeilo Road,  
Near Llandybie, Carmarthenshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)  
Order 2011**

*Made* 25 August 2011

*Coming into force* 6 September 2011

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited by reason of works proposed to be executed thereon.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

**1.** This Order comes into force on 6 September 2011 and its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Cilyrychen Level Crossing, Llandeilo Road, Near Llandybie, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2011.

**2.** —1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means that length of the A483 trunk road at Cilyrychen Level Crossing, to the north of Llandybie, in the County of Carmarthenshire, that extends from a point approximately 20 metres either side of the said crossing;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 6 September 2011 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been removed.
