The National Assembly for Wales makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 15(4), 32(2) and 88(2) of the Animal Health Act 1981(1) and now vested in it:

#### Title, commencement and application

**1.**—(1) The title of this Order is the Specified Diseases (Notification and Slaughter) (Wales) Order 2006.

- (2) This Order comes into force on 29 August 2006.
- (3) This Order applies in relation to Wales.

#### Amendment of the Specified Diseases (Notification and Slaughter) Order 1992

**2.** In article 2(1) (application of section 32 of the Animal Health Act 1981) of the Specified Diseases (Notification and Slaughter) Order 1992(**2**) after "Epizootic haemorrhagic virus disease" insert "Equine infectious anaemia".

### Amendment of the Specified Diseases (Notification) Order 1996

**3.** In Part I of Schedule 1 (specified diseases) to the Specified Diseases (Notification) Order 1996(**3**) after "Epizootic haemorrhagic virus disease" insert "Equine infectious anaemia".
