The Board of Trade in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 7 of the Trading with the Enemy Act, 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf do hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. Articles 1, 4 and 5 of the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1939(a) (requiring payment of certain moneys to the Custodian and imposing restrictions and requirements in regard to certain property in the United Kingdom) shall not apply to—
 - (a) any money which would but for the existence of a state of war become payable to or for the benefit or any person within the description contained in Article 2 of this Order on or after the date of this Order,
