#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Buckinghamshire (Structural Changes) (Supplementary Provision and Amendment) Order 2020 and comes into force on 1st April 2020.

# Amendment of the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Establishment of Conservation Board) Order 2004

- **2.**—(1) The Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Establishment of Conservation Board) Order 2004(4) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).
  - (2) For article 5 (appointment of local authority members) substitute—
    - "5.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), each local authority specified in Schedule 1 (being collectively the local authorities for the areas wholly or partly comprised in the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty) shall appoint one member to the Board.
