ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Belfast Road, Carrickfergus (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016

Made - - - - *18th October 2016*

Coming into operation - *8th November 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 38(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Belfast Road, Carrickfergus (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 8th November 2016.

Part-time speed limit

2.—(1) A person shall not drive a motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) A 20 miles per hour speed limit applies to the length of road specified in the Schedule when a 20 miles per hour speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997^(d).
