COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1803/2006
of 7 December 2006

amending Regulations (EC) No 2771/1999 and (EC) No 1898/2005
as regards the entry into storage of intervention butter put on sale

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1255/1999 of 17 May 1999 on the common organisation of the market in milk and milk products⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 10 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Article 21 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 2771/1999 of 16 December 1999 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No 1255/1999 as regards intervention on the market in butter and cream⁽²⁾ lays down that intervention butter placed on sale must have entered into storage before 1 May 2006.
- (2) Article 1(a) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 1898/2005 of 9 November 2005 laying down detailed rules for implementing Council Regulation (EC) No 1255/1999 as regards measures for the disposal of cream, butter and concentrated butter on the Community market⁽³⁾ lays down that intervention butter bought in under Article 6(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1255/1999 to be sold at reduced prices must have been taken into storage before 1 May 2006.
- (3) Given the situation on the butter market and the quantities of butter in intervention storage it is appropriate that butter in storage before 1 September 2006 should be available for sale.
- (4) Regulations (EC) No 2771/1999 and (EC) No 1898/2005 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (5) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 21 of Regulation (EC) No 2771/1999, ‘1 May 2006’ is replaced by ‘1 September 2006’.

Article 2

In Article 1(a) of Regulation (EC) No 1898/2005, ‘1 May 2006’ is replaced by ‘1 September 2006’.

Changes to legislation: There are currently no known outstanding effects for the

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
