**One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 1981**

Made 20th May 1981

Coming into operation 6th July 1981

The Department of the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 and shall come into operation on 6th July 1981.

Amendments

2. The One-Way Traffic (Belfast-Newtownabbey) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980(b) shall be amended by the—

- (a) deletion from the schedule of the item relating to West Street, Belfast;
- (b) addition to the schedule of the items specified in schedule 1;
- (c) substitution for the items relating to Gloucester Street, Belfast and Great Patrick Street, Belfast, in column 1 of the schedule of the items specified in schedule 2.
