

GENERAL DEALERS**Applications for Licences**

RULES, DATED 16TH NOVEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE GENERAL DEALERS (IRELAND) ACT 1903.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 11 of the General Dealers (Ireland) Act 1903(a), section 44(2) of the Government of Ireland Act 1920(b), section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(c), and of every other power enabling me in that behalf I hereby make the following Rules:—

Citation

1. These Rules may be cited as the General Dealers (Licensing) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1973.

Interpretation of "principal Rules"

2. In these Rules the expression "principal Rules" means the Rules dated 14th August 1905(d) made by the Lord Chancellor of Ireland under section 11 of the General Dealers (Ireland) Act 1903.

Amendment of principal Rules

3. For Rule 5 of the principal Rules there shall be substituted the following Rule:—

"5. An application for a licence under the Act or a renewal thereof may be made to any sitting of the court as licensing authority."
