## SALARIES

**Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 1973**

*Made* . . . . . 19th October 1973

*Coming into operation* . . . . . 26th November 1973

*To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom  
under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern  
Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(a) and by Articles 3 and 4 of the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 26th November 1973.

*Increase of certain salaries*

2. As from 1st April 1973, the salaries paid to the Comptroller and Auditor-General, the Parliamentary Commissioner and the Commissioner for Complaints shall be increased to £9,625 a year.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order increases the salaries of the Comptroller and Auditor-General for Northern Ireland, the Northern Ireland Parliamentary Commissioner for Administration and the Northern Ireland Commissioner for Complaints to £9,625 a year with effect from 1st April 1973.
