SALARIES

Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973

Coming into operation . . . 26th November 1973

To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section .1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(a) and by Articles 3 and 4 of the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor-General and Others) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 26th November 1973.

Increase of certain salaries

2. As from 1st April 1973, the salaries paid to the Comptroller and Auditor-General, the Parliamentary Commissioner and the Commissioner for Complaints shall be increased to £9,625 a year.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order increases the salaries of the Comptroller and Auditor-General for Northern Ireland, the Northern Ireland Parliamentary Commissioner for Administration and the Northern Ireland Commissioner for Complaints to £9,625 a year with effect from 1st April 1973.
