- (d) coordination of national development plans with the National Planning Framework;
- (e) a participatory and decentralised national planning and budgeting process which promotes the participation of state and non state actors in the planning and budgeting process;
- (f) evidence based decision making in national planning and budgeting;
- (g) enhanced budget credibility; and
- (h) matters connected with, or incidental to, the foregoing.

ENTITLED
