THE MOBILE ISSUANCE OF NATIONAL REGISTRATION CARDS (NRCs) BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL REGISTRATION, PASSPORT AND CITIZENSHIP ENDED ON 31ST JANUARY 2016.

PHASE I OF THE EXERCISE COVERED, MUCHINGA, NORTHERN, AND CENTRAL PROVINCES.

PHASE II OF THE EXERCISE COVERED, LUSAKA, SOUTHERN, EASTERN AND WESTERN PROVINCES.

PHASE III OF THE EXERCISE COVERED, COPPERBELT, LUAPULA AND NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCES

MR. SPEAKER SIR,

IN PHASE I OF THE EXERCISE, THE DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL REGISTRATION, PASSPORT AND CITIZENSHIP, REGISTERED A TOTAL OF 409, 638 WITH A BREAK DOWN IN EACH PROVINCE AS FOLLOWS;

MUCHINGA PROVINCE: 104,071 PERSONS WERE REGISTERED AGAINST A TARGET OF 70,000 PERSONS

NORTHERN PROVINCE: 135,584 PERSONS WERE REGISTERED AGAINST A TARGET OF 80,000 PERSONS

CENTRAL PROVINCE: 169,983 PERSONS WERE REGISTERED AGAINST A TARGET OF 95,000 PERSONS

A TOTAL OF K47 MILLION WAS SPENT ON THIS PHASE.
