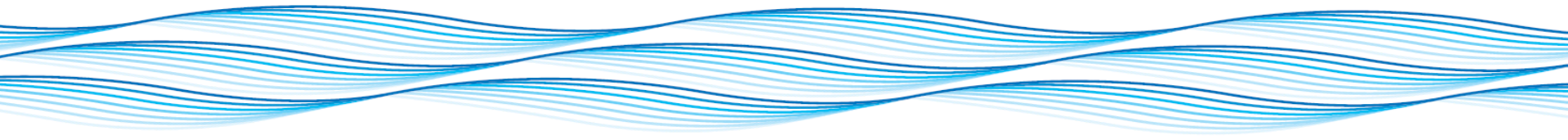

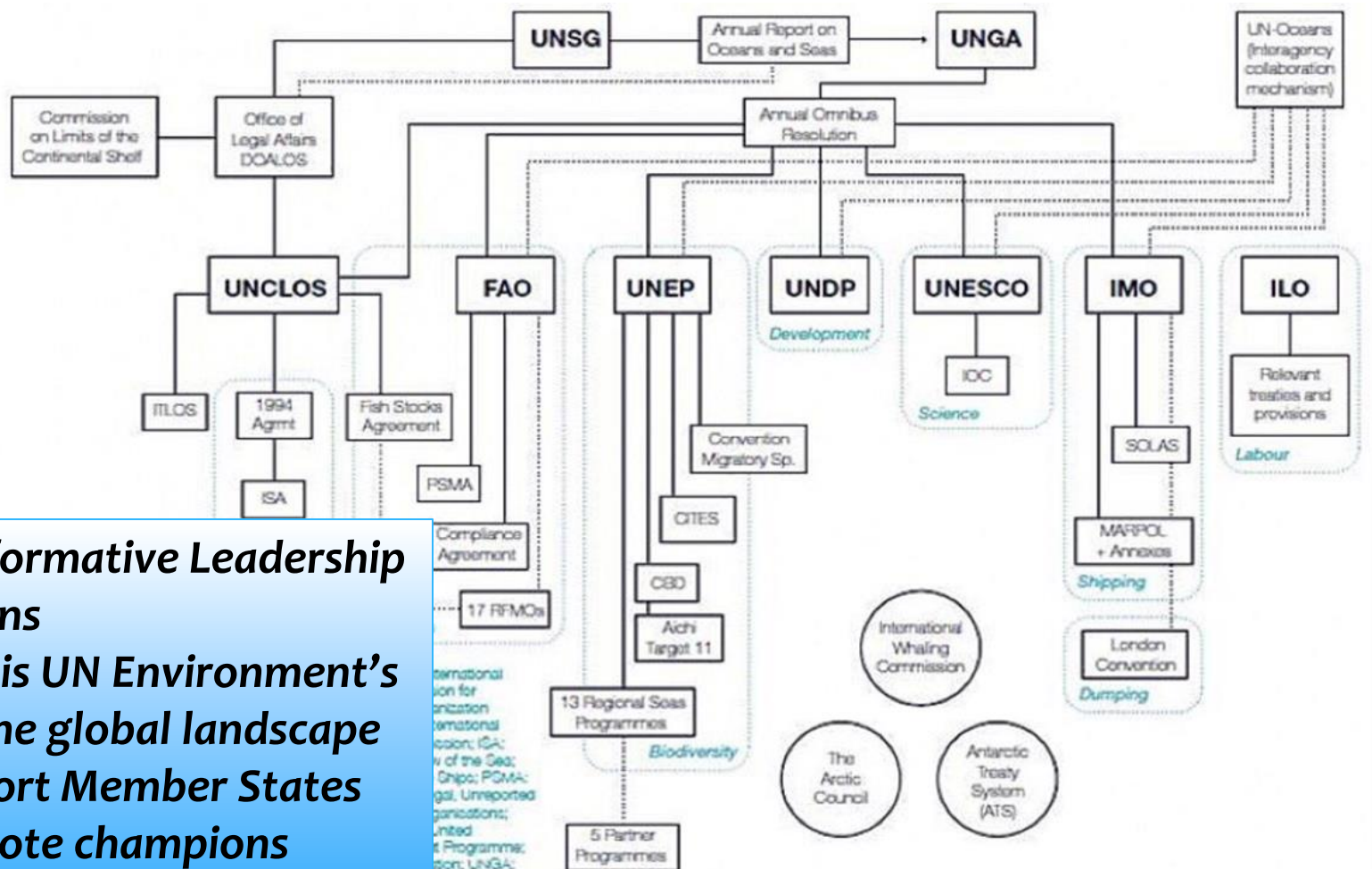


Focus on Ocean – Why

- * Knowledge and capacity increase on how to use and extract marine resources
- * Increased political relevance
- * Lack of Governance the key challenge
- * New Leadership in UN Environment



Patchwork of instruments



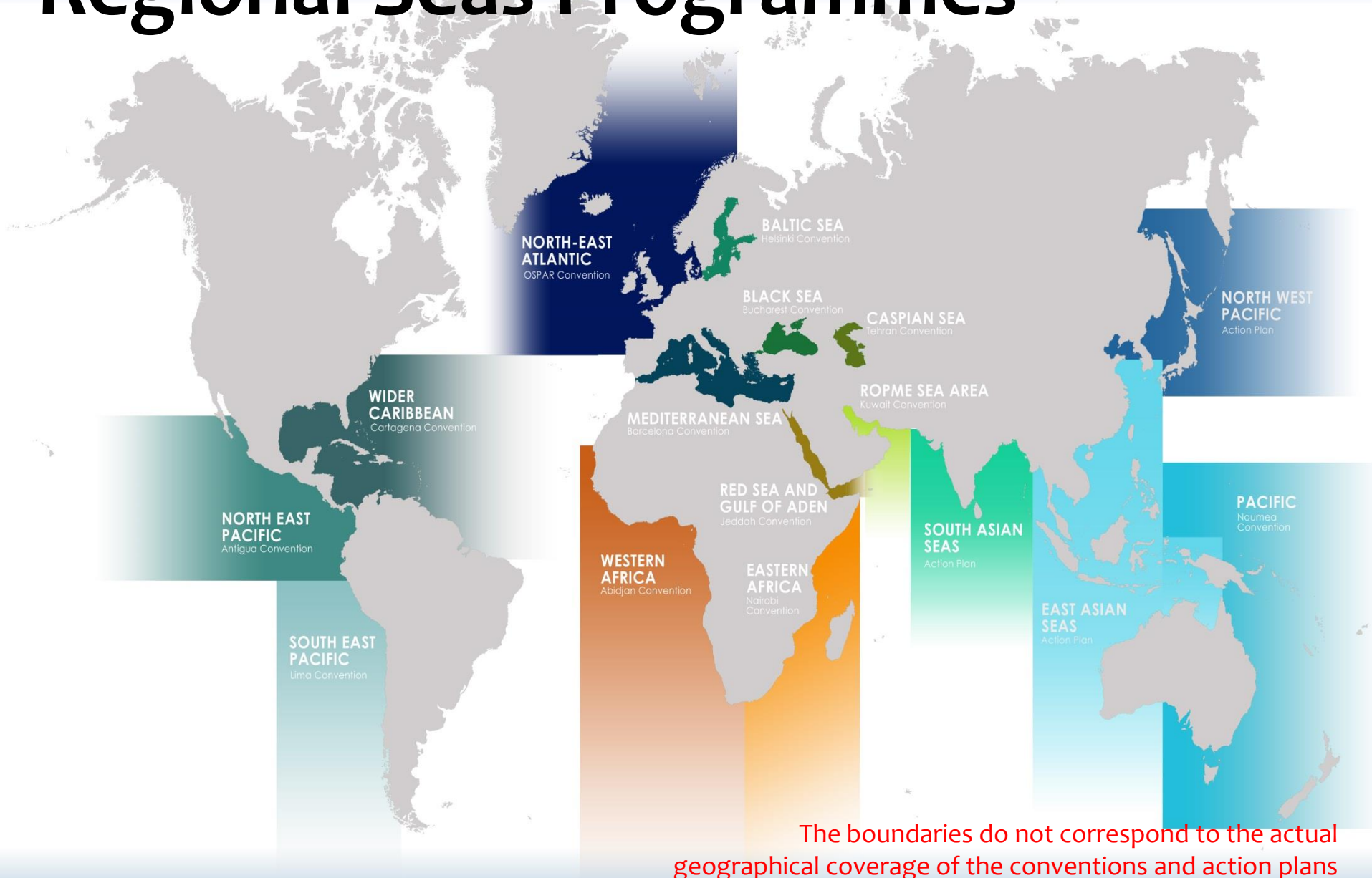
A Transformative Leadership for oceans

Regional Ocean Governance

- UN Environment assists 18 Regional Ocean Governance mechanisms (7 hosted by UN Environment)
 - Needs to be strengthened
 - Increase visibility and awareness
 - Exchange of experience and knowledge
 - Resource mobilization
 - Facilitating partnerships with scientific institutions and the private sector
- Coordination between Regional Seas, UN bodies, Regional Fisheries Bodies, Large Marine Ecosystems
- Implementing mechanism for agreed ocean-related SDG targets and indicators
- Platform for innovative partnership with private, NGOs, Gov

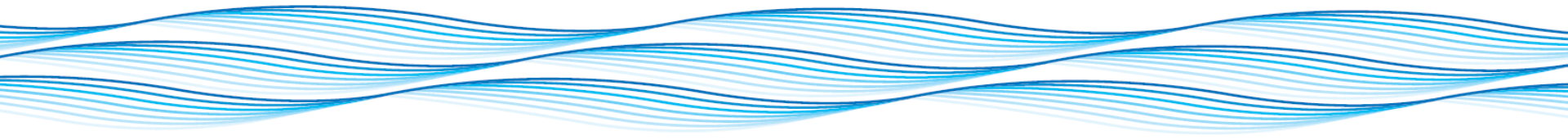
Regional Seas Programmes

Enhanced Ocean Partnership

- The Global Programme of Action for the Protection of the Marine Environment from Land-based Activities (GPA)
- Combat Land-based Pollutions– stop pollution by its source
- Marine litter, nutrients and wastewater
- The linkages to coral reefs, food security, acidification etc
- Potential to an innovative mechanism for collaboration with private sector and other related stakeholders
- Are we fit for purpose? Need for revitalized commitment
