

Introduction of the Committee



Established as RFB by the Convention of Cotonou, in November 2007

The scope of application of FCWC is all marine waters under national jurisdiction of the six contracting Parties:

Liberia, Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana, Togo, Benin and Nigeria,

Mains challenges of the sub region

- The West Central Gulf of Guinea is not so productive, although the population densities of the coastal countries are among the highest in the region
- Intensive fishing activities of foreign vessels,
- poor management of fisheries stocks,
- Iow participation of stakeholders in the fisheries manangement
- and IUU fishing activities .

The socio-economic consequences of this situation are serious and include in particular, food insecurity, health problems, and increased conflicts in the fisheries sector.

Objectives


- Promote cooperation among the Contracting Parties with a view to ensuring the conservation and optimum utilization of the living marine resources.




Majors achievement
