**I. INTRODUCTION**

**II. VENUE**

These high-level SPECA events will take place on 22-23 November 2016 at the Ramada Plaza Gence Hotel in Ganja (address: 519 Nizami Ganjavi ave., AZ2019, Ganja, Azerbaijan).
