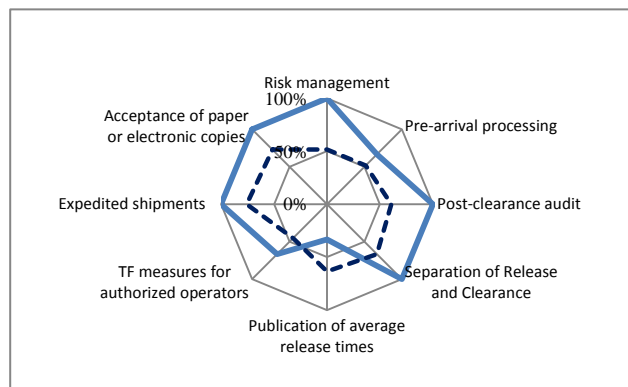

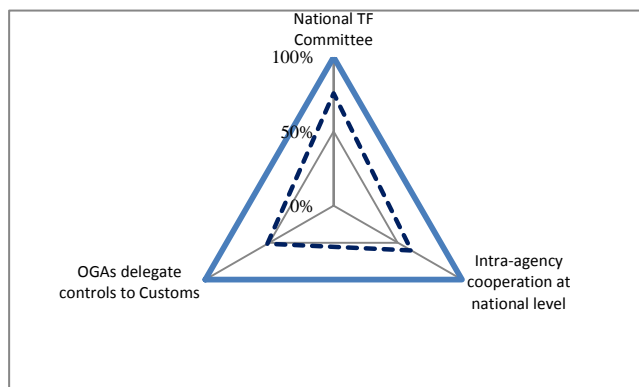

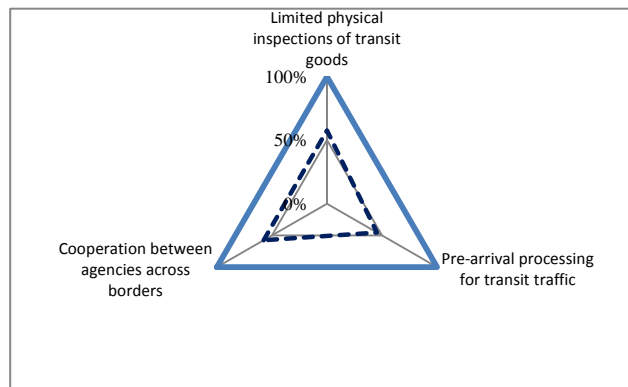

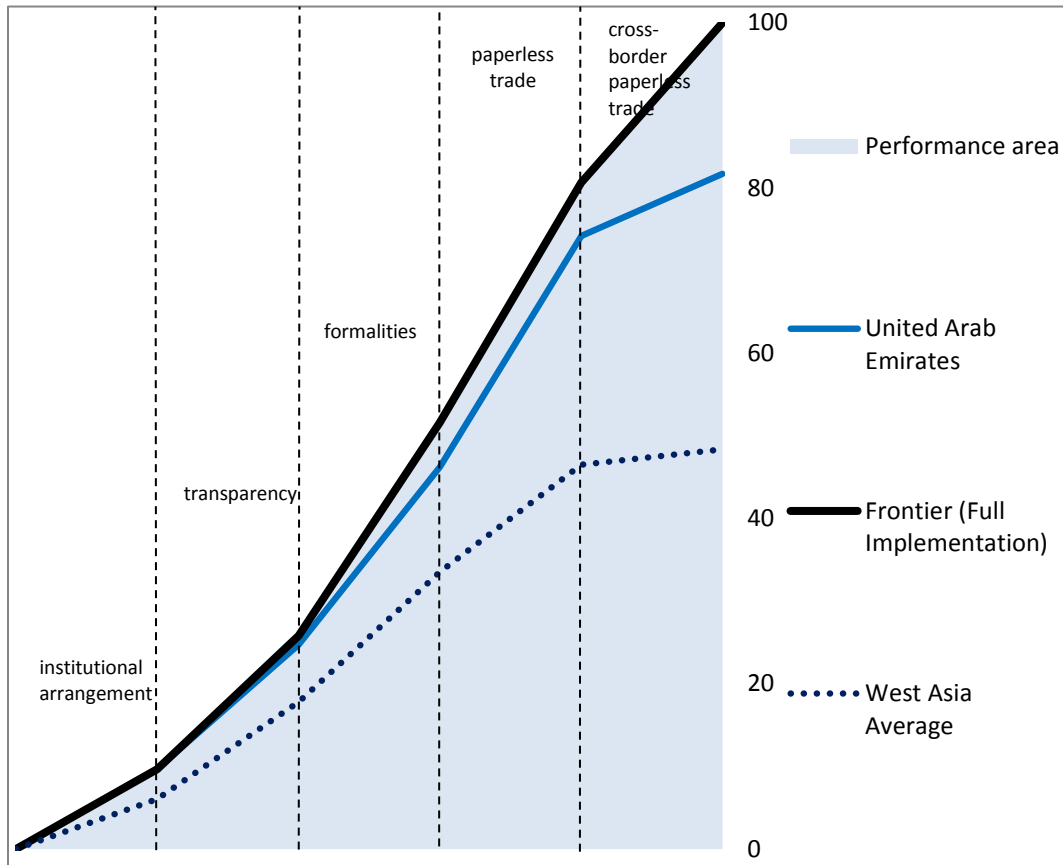

Moving up the trade facilitation ladder towards seamless international supply chains

[Cumulative implementation scores of core groups of measures; full implementation =100]



The level of implementation of trade facilitation measures in the United Arab Emirates (81.8%) is well above the level in West Asia (48.4%). Among the five core groups of trade facilitation measures, the most implemented in the United Arab Emirates are ‘Institutional arrangement and cooperation’ measures (100%). The least implemented are “Cross-border paperless trade” measures (38.9%). “Transit” measures achieve the full score.

Implementation of “Transparency” measures is well above the regional average. The least implemented measure in this group is *Advance ruling*. Analogously, implementation of “Formalities” measures is above 80%. However, significant room for improvement remains for *Publication of average release time*.

In “Paperless trade”, the UAE’s implementation is above the regional average. The least implemented measure in this group is *E-Single Window*.

The United Arab Emirates may focus its trade facilitation efforts in particular on full implementation of “Formalities” measures, as well as on moving towards “Cross-border paperless trade”.
