


Services are tradable




Services value added

Share of services in exports, 2011




Services VA in world gross exports, by manufacturing industry, 2011

STRI is a regulatory database

- Standardised set of measures, with links to sources
- 42 countries
 - Colombia, Lithuania and Malaysia
- 22 sectors
- 2 years for seven sectors
