
The Outcomes

- **Safer Houses:** 7,972 houses, using earthquake and multi hazard resistant features.
- **Better Builders:** A total of 1,000 local masons and their assistants received hand-on training under this project and were actively involved in the earthquake resistant house construction.
- **Aware Citizens:** A comprehensive awareness raising initiative extending to civil society organisations, elected representatives and schools

- **Trained Engineers:** More than 300 engineers got trained in disaster resistant house construction techniques.
- **Empowered Homeowners :** About 8,000 homeowners comprising of 40,000 individuals are getting empowered by the homeowner driven construction strategy.
