Trade Facilitation Work Programme

- ➤ Adoption of ASEAN Trade Facilitation Work Programme in 2008.
- ASEAN Trade Facilitation Work Programme covers:
 - Elimination of tariffs and NTBs
 - Enhancement of Rules of Origin
 - Customs Integration and ASEAN Single Window
 - Harmonization of Standards and Conformance Procedures



Elimination of Tariff and NTB

- ➤ Elimination of Tariffs: At present 95.99% of ATIGA Tariff lines are eliminated.
- **Elimination of NTBs:**
- (i) Adoption of Work Programme on NTM;
- (ii) Establishment of Interagency body in each AMS;
- (iii) Discussion of cases in the Matrix of Actual Cases on NTMs/trade barriers and the pilot project/case studies on NTMs;
- (iv) Elimination of TRQs; and
- (v) Re-alignment of ASEAN NTM database with the 2012 UNCTAD NTM classification.



Enhancement of Rules of Origin (ROO)

- Continuous revision of ASEAN ROO and Operational Certification Procedures (OCP) to be trade-facilitative and responsive to global production changes.
- Products Specific Rules (PSR):
 - Undertaking sectoral studies to come up with the most appropriate ROO for automotive, and iron and steel products.
- ASEAN Self-certification System:
 - Implementation of pilot projects on ASEAN Self-certification scheme;
 - Work towards the realisation of ASEAN Self-certification System.

Trade Facilitation Mechanism

- ➤ Establishment of ASEAN Trade Repository which is as a web portal, a single point of access to ASEAN Member States' trade-related information on their NTR.
- Reactivation of the ASEAN Trade Facilitation Joint Consultative Committee (ATF-JCC) with the participation of the private sector.
- ➤ Revitalisation of the consultation mechanism through the establishment of the ASEAN Solutions for Investments, Services and Trade (ASSIST).



Customs Integration

- > ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature
 - Protocol Governing the Implementation of ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) signed in 2003 to establish uniformity of application in the classification of goods in ASEAN.
- > ASEAN Customs Transit System
 - Provided in the Protocol 7 of the ASEAN Framework Agreement on the Facilitation of Goods in Transit (AFAFGIT) and its Technical Appendix signed in 1998.
- > ASEAN Single Window
