2. Global and regional overview of sustainable transport policies and practices

This session will introduce global transport mandates and policies relating to sustainable and inclusive transport development. It will present the concepts, emerging trends and practices in planning and designing sustainable and inclusive transportation systems.

3. Integrated transport planning and institutional coordination

This session will elaborate on the principles and elements of integrated land use and transport planning with examples of best practices. It will also discuss institutional aspects and ways to enhance coordination among various stakeholders in implementation of integrated policies and projects as one of the challenges faced by countries is to ensure policy coordination/harmonization at national, local and city levels.

4. Sustainable national and urban transport systems

Asian countries and city authorities, including those in North and Central Asia, are finding it difficult to provide sustainable and inclusive transport systems to meet the mobility needs of people as a result of growing transport demand and rapid urbanization taking place in the developing world. This session will consider sustainable transport and urban transport issues in Asian context and discuss policies and examples of sustainable transportation systems. It will also include examples of urban transport systems such as MRT, BRT, emerging transit options, vehicle fuel economy and emissions standards, planning non-motorized transport and road safety.

5. Selected country and city experience in developing sustainable transport systems

This session will introduce existing national and urban transport strategies, policies and practices from selected countries and cities, including from the North and Central Asian subregion. It will highlight the issues and challenges faced by countries, capital and secondary cities in developing sustainable transport systems.
