

NAMA development

The development of the “Waste-to-Resource” NAMA was conceptualized as three main stages...




- Elaboration of a detailed NAMA-design study
- Consultation and inputs of stakeholders
- Identification of sources of international climate financing
- Formalize approval of the NAMA

- Capacity building for stakeholders on waste management practices and the NAMA arrangements
- Identification and implementation of pilot projects

- Full deployment of the NAMA programme throughout cities in Viet Nam

Immediate next steps

Phase I of the NAMA development process will be complete once the design-study is finalized...



Ideas for Phase II

Upon completion of the NAMA design phase, suggested next steps are as follows...

- Set-up proposed NAMA Management Board, clarifying roles and responsibilities of stakeholders involved (e.g. MoC, VEA, VEPPF)
- Set-up and implementation of MRV procedures
- Conduct capacity building initiatives, including the preparation of training materials and sessions
