Geography

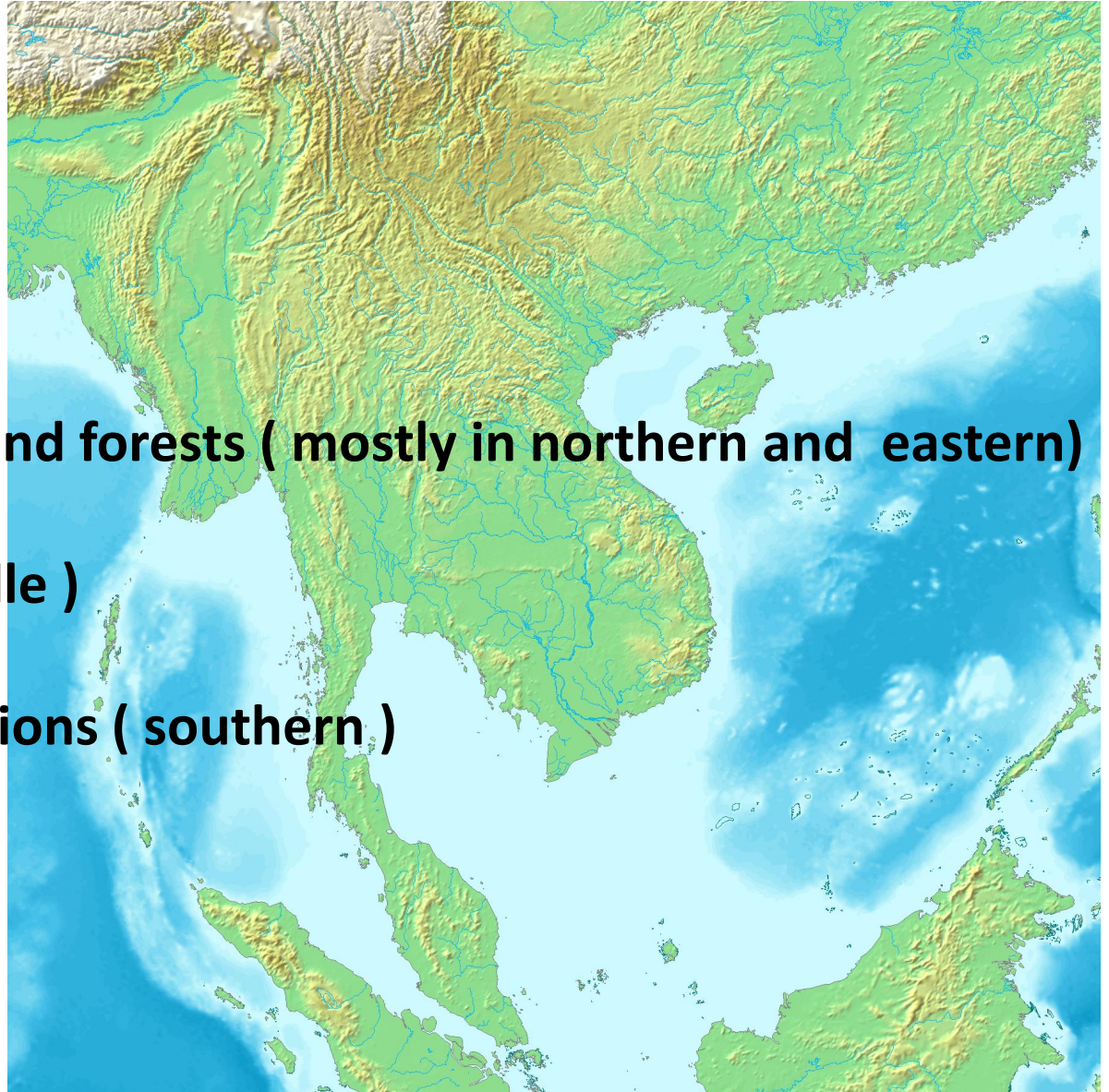
- largest on the mainland in South-East Asia
- total land area: 676,577 square kilometer
- International borders: 5,858 Kilometer
(Bangladesh, India, China, Thailand and Laos)
- total coastal line length: 2,832 kilometer.

- 50% of mountains and forests (mostly in northern and eastern)
- plains region (middle)
- delta and valley regions (southern)

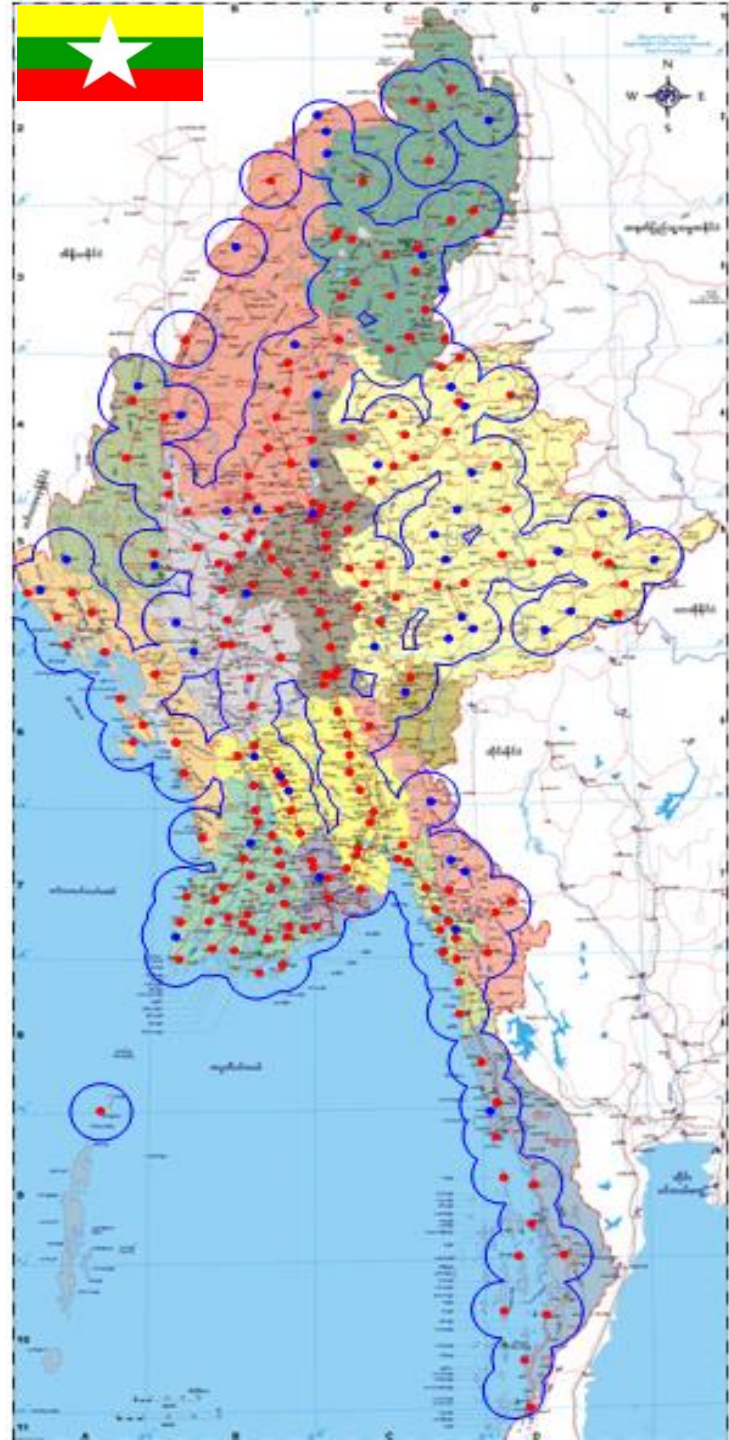
- **Population:** 51 million
