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#### **ESCAP initiatives to enhance regional connectivity**

- Inter Governmental Agreements on Asian Highway, Trans-Asian Railway Networks and the Dry Ports
- ❖ Busan Declaration on Transport Development in Asia and the Pacific (2006), 3 I's vision for transport and logistic system for the region
- 31's are International, Inter-modal and Interconnected
- ESCAP resolution 48/11
- Transport facilitation is inherently challenging
  - Involves numerous government agencies and countries
  - Different institutional environment
  - Implementation capacities
- Increasing importance of non- physical and need for a comprehensive approach. ESCAP member countries adopted a Regional Strategic Framework in 2012





## Regional Strategic Framework for Facilitation of International Road Transport

### Fundamental issues in facilitation of international road transport

- \* Road transport permits and traffic rights
- Visa issues
- Temporary importation of road vehicles
- Insurance of vehicles
- Vehicles weight and dimensions
- Vehicle registration and inspection certificate





## Regional Strategic Framework for Facilitation of International Road Transport

### Key modalities for facilitation international road transport

- Building an effective legal regime
- Wider application of new technologies
- Development of professional training
- Establishment and strengthening of national coordination mechanisms
- Promotion of joint controls at border crossings
- Promotion of economic zones at border crossings
- Application of facilitation tools






### 2. Proposed Regional Cooperation Framework for facilitation of international railway transport

# Fundamental issues in facilitation of international railway transport

- Standardisation of Railway infrastructure and rolling stock
- Break –of –gauge
- Different legal regimes for railway transport contracts
- Coordination of regulatory controls






## <u>Proposed Regional Cooperation Framework for facilitation of international railway transport</u>

#### Potential areas for Cooperation

- Participate in international railway organizations
- Formulate bilateral/subregional agreements
- Collaborate to standardize cross border railway operations
- Use advance cargo information systems
- Arrangement for exchange of wagons
- Use new technologies in train operations and in container tracking






## <u>Proposed Regional Cooperation Framework for facilitation of international railway transport</u>

#### Potential areas for Cooperation

- Develop human resources for cross border railway operations
- Establish dry ports/logistics centers and maintenance hubs near border interchange stations
- Simplify intermodal interfaces of railway with other modes
- Promote and encourage corridor approach to facilitation of international railway transport
- Work towards paperless freight






#### 3. ESCAP transport facilitation models

#### Secure cross border transport model

- Provides concept for vehicle tracking system
- Uses new technologies SPS, RFID,CCS, Electronic Seals
- Physical inspection at origin/destination addresses concerns of security, diversion of goods
- Balances control requirements and facilitation



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
