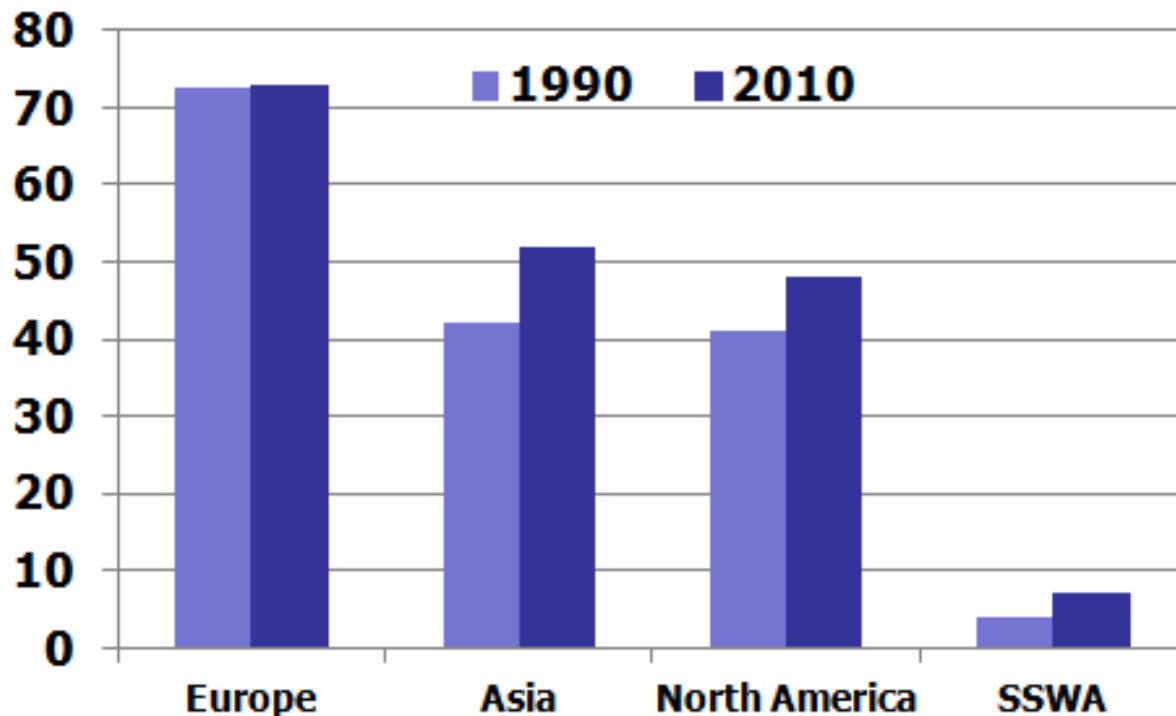

# What Happened at the G20 Summit in Brisbane this week?

- Turkey took over G20 Presidency
- Infrastructure as an emerging priority
  - ➔ But the focus is on finance and investment
- We think that regional connectivity is highly important
- Investments need to focus on bringing forward complementarities

# Connectivity and trade integration goes hand in hand

**Share of intra-regional trade in region's total exports**  
Europe, Asia, North America, and South Asia 1990 and 2010



- Could India and Pakistan, or India and China do what France and Germany did?
- No wonder Nobel Peace Prize was given to the EU (as opposed to ASEAN or NAFTA)

# SSWA region lags behind in terms of connectivity

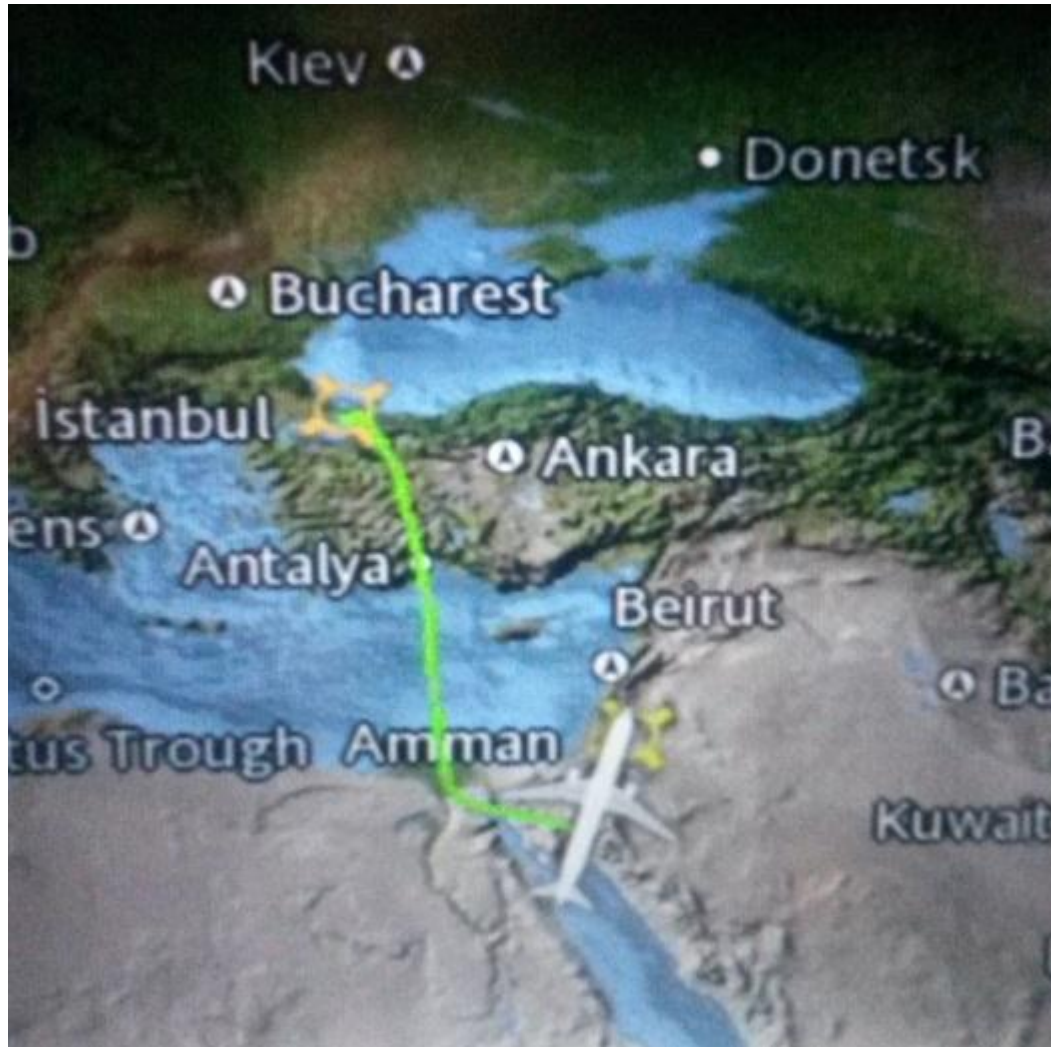

# How would you ship your cargo from Istanbul to Karachi or Mumbai?

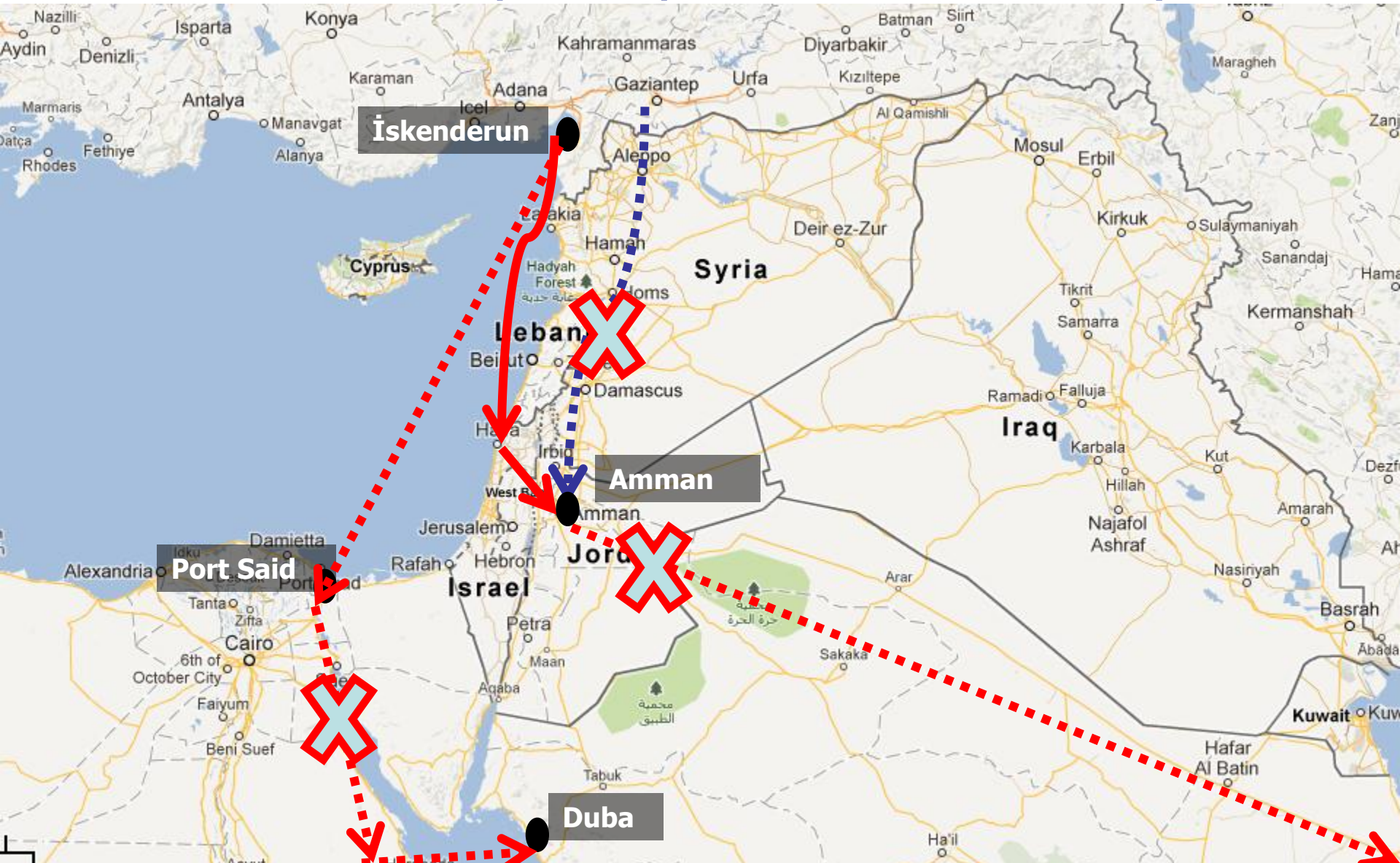


Security and political problems are major obstacles to regional connectivity
