

Focus Areas

Sustainable and Inclusive Transport

This session introduces the global transport mandates and policies relating to sustainable and inclusive transport development. It also present the concepts, emerging trends and practices in planning and designing sustainable urban mobility. Adopting 'Smart cities and Smart mobility' approach is discussed as sustainable and inclusive transport development strategy.

Global and Regional perspectives in planning and developing sustainable urban transportation systems and the role of BRTS

The focus of this theme is to cover the planning perspectives at the global and regional level for the development of sustainable urban transport system s for our cities. The session will throw light on perspectives and experiences of developing sustainable transport systems with focus on BRTS from Latin America, South East Asia and the Indian subcontinent.

Urban Transport Financial & Institutional Sustainability

This session deals with financial and institutional issues relating development of sustainable and inclusive urban transport development. The options such as establishing Urban Mass Transit Development Authority vis-à-vis the role of existing agencies, alternative financing mechanisms including land value capture and the role of PPP arrangements in Bus Transport Operations are being discussed.

Urban Road Safety & Environment

In most Asian cities, road fatalities are major cause of mortality. India sees 150,000 deaths a year, 10% of global road fatalities. Most people dying are vulnerable road users. The effect of untimely death has inter-generational impacts. In addition to causalities due to road accidents, transport is also a public health issue as many urban dwellers suffer from air quality related diseases. This session discusses on urban transport impacts on security, safety and health. Further, the initiatives under Asian Environmentally Sustainable Transport are presented.

Integrated Land-use Transport Planning

Integrating land use and transport, integrating modes, focus on non-motorised transport is core strategies towards achieving sustainable and inclusive transport. This session covers concept and practices through case studies.

Selected country experience in developing sustainable transport

Sustainable transport development is a global issue but has to be placed with in the local context. Each country, state and regions pursue policies and programmes which are contextually relevant. This session bring together experiences from India, Thailand and China.

City Presentations

The programme is focussed both on concepts, policies and strategies at the macro level as well as innovations taking place at the city level. A series of city presentations covering best practices and emerging issues in develop public transport in general and BRTS in specific will be made.

Mayors and City Executive's Forum

This moderated roundtable discusses major challenges and issues faced by city authorities and further elaborate specific challenges faced by secondary cities. It also present ongoing efforts of city authorities to address sustainability of urban public transportation system, share best practices, successful examples and lessons learned.

Asia BRTS and India BRTS Association

This session focuses on the formation of two associations which will act as platform for knowledge sharing and promotion of BRTS in the region.

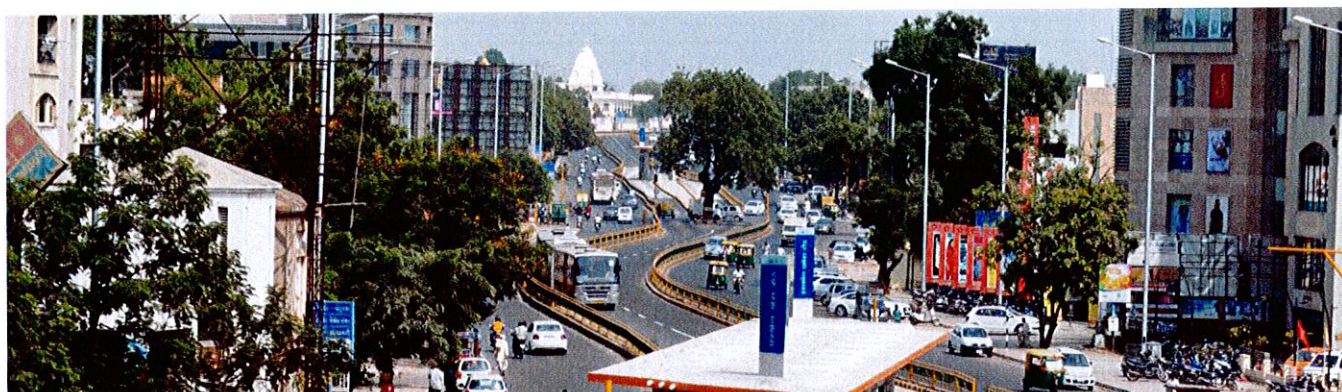
