# Regionalization of the post 2015 Development Agenda and Regional Monitoring Frame works.

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#### MDGs and South Asia

- Size of population almost 1/5<sup>th</sup> of the world community
- Level of development: struggling for fundamental needs such as food and nutrition security, health and sanitation, education and enterprises and sustainable management of natural resources
- MDGs encouraging performance as discussed in previous sessions, but still realizes the need to refocus in unfinished agenda of MDGs and issue of sustainability

## MDGs and SAARC Development Goals-SDGs

- In line with MDGs 8 Goals and further enhanced regional Goals and targets in partnership with UNDP, SAARC developed SDGs with 22 Goals and 67 targets for the period of 2005-2012
- The third Ministerial Meeting on Poverty Alleviation in 2013 in Kathmandu expanded the SDGs period till 2015 coinciding with MDGs period

### Regional Monitoring Mechanism of SDGs

- SAARC Member States had agreed to adopt/streamline the SDGs in their national development priority
- SAARC in partnership with UNDP has been publishing Regional Poverty Profile-RPP focused in particular theme of MGGs/ SDGs
- Member States decide themes for RPPs and Inter Governmental Expert Group (IGEG) suggests the Framework and provides guidelines of the reports
- The fifth RPP published in 2013 was focused in inclusive growth, food and nutrition security for the poor people

#### Contd.....

- Data for all RPPs were provided mainly by the Planning Commissions of the Member States
- SAARC Secretariat had used lead consultant and consultants' expertise from the region for preparing RPPs
- UNDP was providing the technical assistance for all the Reports.
- In addition of that SAARC had Mid term review of SDGs
- Final review is in process
- The last RPP in its series is focused in final review of SAARC Develop Goals

# Challenges for regional monitoring

- Though, SDGs were developed inline with MDGs but with additional ambitions setting 22 goals and 67 targets
- It is difficult to get data from Member States especially in expanded Goals and Targets of SDGs
- No additional resources were mobilized for effective implementation of SDGs, other than SAARC's regular activities with its limited resources from Member States and
- UNDP is supporting SAARC from regionalization to monitoring of SDGs at technical level
