
PRDR PACIFIC REGIONAL DATA REPOSITORY FOR SE4ALL SUSTAINABLE ENERGY FOR ALL

"Strengthening South-South Cooperation to Increase the Affordability of Sustainable Energy Options in Asia and the Pacific"

Over an 18-month period in 2013-2014, this project aimed to further build the capacity of policymakers on utilizing South-South cooperation opportunities and developing country/subregion strategies to increase the affordability of sustainable energy options in Asia and the Pacific.



In the Pacific, requests from member States triggered a multi-stakeholder process facilitated by ESCAP that culminated in the **Project Proposal on the PRDR for SE4AII**. The PRDR is a transnational, online energy database.

In April 2014, Energy Ministers gathered in Nadi at the SPC meeting

Endorsed the PRDR Project Proposal and a Steering Committee to provide guidance and oversight

Designated the Secretariat of the Pacific Community (SPC) as the interim host to lead the implementation of the proposal (final decision to be made in 2015)

Agreed to organize a side event on the PRDR at the Third International SIDS Conference in Apia, Samoa in September 2014

February 2013

Participants at ESCAP Expert Group Meeting in Suva, Fiji request that focus in the Pacific be on developing an energy data and information system

May 2013

Ministers at Asian and Pacific Energy Forum convened by ESCAP in Vladivostok, Russian Federation adopt the Ministerial Declaration and the Plan of Action which includes establishing a framework for acquiring energy data and information

September 2013

Leaders meet with the UN Secretary-General in New York to handover the **Declaration on** Establishing the PRDR for SE4All signed by 11 heads of state and ministers

April 2014

Ministers endorse Project Proposal on PRDR at Second Meeting of Pacific Ministers of Energy and Transport convened by SPC in Nadi, Fiji

March 2013

Leaders at Pacific Leaders Energy Summit hosted by Tonga in Nuku'alofa agree to request ESCAP to commence the process for a regional data repository

August 2013

Leaders at 44th Pacific Island Leaders Forum convened by PIF in Majuro, Marshall Islands, agree to meet with the UN Secretary-General in support of SE4ALL during the sidelines of the General Assembly

December 2013

Participants at ESCAP Technical Workshop on PRDR in Suva discuss energy data priorities, implementation strategy and next steps

June 2014

Participants at ESCAP Knowledge Dissemination Workshop in Bangkok share learning points and discuss implementation and sustainability

The PRDR Project Proposal highlights the importance of simplicity and independence and of implementation principles such as first focusing on raw/primary data and getting data directly from the source, wherever possible.

Key benefits envisaged from an operational PRDR include:

- Timely and easy access to reliable, up-to-date energy data
- Smooth supply chain for energy data collection and dissemination
- Strengthened foundation for evidenced-based policies and projects on energy







The Sustainable Energy for All (SE4All) Initiative is co-led by the United Nations and the World Bank to bring together partners to mobilize action from all sectors of society in support of three interlinked objectives: providing universal access to modern energy services, doubling the global rate of improvement in energy efficiency, and doubling the share of renewable energy in the global energy mix, all by 2030.





The Asian and Pacific Energy Forum (APEF) in 2013 was the first regional ministerial conference on energy convened by the United Nations. Following a step-by-step preparatory process organized by ESCAP, ministers adopted the Ministerial Declaration and Plan of Action (2014-2018) on Regional Cooperation for Enhanced Energy Security and the Sustainable Use of Energy in Asia and the Pacific.

The PRDR will provide key data and information to track progress on the APEF action items and SE4All objectives.

In order to increase the affordability of sustainable energy options in the Pacific, overcome the key challenge in the lack of quality, bankable data

Establish a transnational, online repository of energy data and information to build an enabling environment for achieving the goals of Sustainable Energy for All (SE4AII)

Strengthen South-South cooperation by identifying a common position, garnering high-level political ownership and implementing agreed-upon actions in the spirit of partnership
