The mortality rate  
of persons with disabilities is  
**DOUBLE**  
that of general population

**0.78%** (general population of Iwate, Miyagi, Fukushima)

**1.43%** (holders of the certificates of persons with disabilities)

## The mortality rate of persons with disabilities in three prefectures

- **Iwate – 1.3 times** as many as general population
- **Miyagi – 2.4 times**
- **Fukushima – 0.8 times**



## Door-to-door survey of persons with disabilities in Rikuzentakata City, Iwate

Conducted by JDF in July – Nov., 2012

### How to get emergency information (MA: 1016 persons)

- Community wireless sound system: 182 persons (20.6%)
- Welfare service providers: 134 (15.2%)
- Neighbors: 126 (14.3%)
- Families, relatives: 123 (13.9%)
- Radio: 32 (3.6%)
- Fire and police dpt.: 26 (2.9%)
- TV: 15 (1.7%)
- Municipality staff: 4 (0.5%)





## JDF support activities for persons with disabilities

- **Three Support Centers**
  - in Iwate, Miyagi, Fukushima
  - in cooperation with the DPOs in respected areas
- **Support Centers are still in operation**
  - Their activities varies according to the areas, times, etc.
- **Door-to-door surveys**
  - Complete surveys of disability certificate holders in;  
Rikuzentakata City, Iwate  
Minamisoma City, Fukushima



## JDF activities for disaster risk reduction

- Proposals to the national government, etc.
  - 10 proposals submitted to date
- Participation in governmental committees concerning DRR
- Production of a documentary film
  - "Messages of Life, twice as many persons with disabilities passed away on March 11"
- 1st Activity report issued
- Activity reports in UN and other meetings
